



#### **UNINSURED**


In 2021, 17.7% of residents under 65 years old were uninsured in Palm Beach County, compared to 15.6% in Florida.



## MATERNAL, INFANT, & CHILD HEALTH

In 2021, the birth rate in Palm Beach County was **9.7 per 1,000 population**, compared to 9.8 per 1,000 population in Florida.

In 2021, the infant mortality rate in Palm Beach County was 5.0 per 1,000 population, compared to 5.9 per 1,000 population in Florida.
